HOME SHARE PROGRAM SUPPORTS AFFORDABLE HOUSING



Affordable housing is a complex issue many cities continue to face. The City of Lacey (City) supports and helps create programs that assist our community members in finding and maintaining affordable places to live. In 2022 as part of the City's affordablehousing program, the City provided \$95,000 to the Senior **Services for South Sound** to pilot the **Home Share Program**.

What is Home Share?

The Home Share Program creates a living arrangement where a Home Provider offers accommodations to a Home Seeker in exchange for an agreed-upon level of support. Each situation is different, based on the support needs of the Home Provider, and may include monetary contributions, assistance with household tasks, transportation, companionship, or a combination of these items.

A University of Washington School of Public Health study found that home sharing is an effective strategy to address housing affordability with more formal, reliable, and relationshipbased solutions. In fact, home sharing tackles two problems at once — helping community members keep their homes, while offering vacant bedrooms to other community members looking for affordable-housing options.

"Home Share is a wonderful way to address the housing crisis in Thurston County on an individual level," states Rebecca Hutchinson, Home Share Program Manager. "We (Senior Services for South Sound) are in a unique position to help people keep their homes by filling their empty bedrooms with people in our community who desperately need access to affordable housing."

What Are the Benefits of Home Sharing?

Home sharing has many positive benefits. One of the main benefits is to lower the cost of living. Many people who apply for the Home Share Program live on a fixed income. Sharing household expenses helps make housing more affordable for both parties. Other benefits can include social support, a greater sense of security, help with household chores and caretaking needs, and more.

How Do Home Providers Get Connected With Home Seekers?

Home Share Program Managers interview and screen all applicants for lifestyle compatibility, check references, and perform thorough criminal background checks. Program Managers match Home Providers with Home Seekers who then spend time getting to know each other to verify their compatibility.
