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The following information presents my findings and comments associated with the request for review application submitted by Christopher Merritt regarding the undeveloped property on 33<sup>rd</sup> Ave SE, TPN 11827310605. I visited the site on December 9, 2024 to review the proposed project and identify any impacts to the existing trees that may occur.

## Findings and Comments

Per my discussion with the property owner, no trees are to be removed as part of this project. It appears that with the location of the silt fencing shown on the provided site plan, the trees within the property will be protected. The fencing should be installed prior to any work within the site.

There is a 24" Douglas fir located within the ROW/Easement at the NE corner of the property that should be protected during construction. This tree is in good condition and protection fencing should be installed along the edge of pavement and the dripline as shown on the attached diagram. No equipment or materials should be allowed within the fencing.
